1 . From Malpensa Airport terminal 1 take Malpensa Express Trains to Milan Downtown and stop at Cadorna Railway Station.

Malpensa Express trains connect the Terminal 1 of Malpensa directly to the centre of **Milan**, (**Cadorna Railway Station connection with the**

Subway  **red and green lines**)

The journey from the Terminal 1 of Malpensa to Cadorna Station lasts about 40 minutes.

2. From Cadorna Station take Subway **Green line direction Famagosta/Abbiategrasso and get off at Porta Genova FS Rail Station**

3. From Porta Genova Railway station take one of trains listed below and get off at Valenza.

Remember that to get to Valenza you have to change train in Mortara and take train direction Alessandria (refer to train number). On Sunday there are only 5 journey are available during the day. More trains are available during the week see http://trenitalia.it/homepage_en.html

1. Proce di in direzione **sud-est** da **SS10/Viale della Repubblica** verso **Via dell'Artigianato** 0,5 km
2. Svolta leggermente a **sinistra** per rimanere su **SS10/Viale della Repubblica** 10 m
3. Svolta leggermente a **destra** in **Via Luigi Galvani** 0,2 km
4. Prosegui dritto su **Via Circonvallazione Ovest** 0,2 km
5. Svolta leggermente a **destra** 0,1 km
6. Svolta a **destra** 63 m
7. Svolta a **destra** 0,2 km
